GUY ANIMALS: (*Sing.*) Doo bee doo! Doo bee doo!

10 **LITTLE RED/GRANDMOTHER/WOLF:** (*Sing.*) On this night...
WOODLAND ANIMALS: (*Sing.*) Sha-doo doo bee doo!
GRANDMOTHER/WOLF: (*Sing.*) You should be happy!

LITTLE RED: (*Sings.*) I should be happy. **WOODLAND ANIMALS:** (*Sing.*)
Sha-doo doo bee doo!

15 **GRANDMOTHER/WOLF:** (*Sing.*) You shouldn't fear.
LITTLE RED: (*Sings.*) I shouldn't fear. **WOODLAND ANIMALS:** (*Sing.*)
Sha-doo doo bee doo!

GRANDMOTHER/WOLF: (*Sing.*) You shouldn't cry.
LITTLE RED: (*Sings.*) I shouldn't cry. **GIRL ANIMALS:** (*Sing.*) Sha-doo doo bee doo!
20 **GUY ANIMALS:** (*Sing.*) Sha-doo doo doo doo bee doo!

GRANDMOTHER/WOLF: (*Sing.*) But on this night...
LITTLE RED: (*Sings.*) But on this night... **WOODLAND ANIMALS:** (*Sing.*)
Sha-doo doo bee doo!

25 **GRANDMOTHER/WOLF:** (*Sing.*) ...you're truly unhappy.
LITTLE RED: (*Sings.*) I'm truly unhappy. **WOODLAND ANIMALS:** (*Sing.*)
Sha-doo doo bee doo!

GRANDMOTHER/WOLF: (*Sing.*) And every tear...
LITTLE RED: (*Sings.*) And every tear... **WOODLAND ANIMALS:** (*Sing.*)
30 Sha-doo doo bee doo!

RED/GRANDMOTHER/WOLF: (*Sing.*) ...will surely be shed...
WOODLAND ANIMALS: (*Sing.*) Sha-doo doo!

LITTLE RED: (*Sings.*) ...the day I'm wooed to be wed!
WOODLAND ANIMALS: (*Sing under the following dialogue.*)
35 Sha-doo doo bee doo!
Sha-doo doo bee doo!
Sha-doo doo bee doo!

GIRL ANIMALS: (*Sing.*) Sha-doo doo bee doo! **GUY ANIMALS:** (*Sing.*)
40 Sha-doo doo bee doo, doo bee doo! (*MUSIC UNDER.*)

- 10 **EVIL QUEEN:** (Sings.) Diabolical, workaholical,

- 15 **ALL:** (Sing.) Hey!
- EVIL QUEEN:** (Sings.) I am the queen of the neighborhood.
I am the Evil Queen!
A curse upon each prince today,
Hear me as I say, today!
- 20 **NARRATOR #2:** (Clicks remote again after the word "today" [on beat
four], STOPPING MUSIC and FREEZING ALL ONSTAGE as NARRATOR
#1 ENTERS DOWN RIGHT. A subtle drum rhythm continues under for
timing. Speaks.) So, are we all clear on the plot?
- NARRATOR #1:** (Speaks.) The princes must succeed in the three
tasks if they are to woo Wed Widing Hood.
- 25 **NARRATOR #2:** (Speaks.) Red Riding Hood. But the Evil Queen will try
to stop them at every turn.
- NARRATOR #1:** (Speaks.) Does that all make sense?
- NARRATOR #2:** (Speaks.) Good, then on we go. (Clicks remote with a
flourish [on beat four]. MUSIC CONTINUES.)
- 30 **ALL:** (Sing.) Hey, hey!
- EVIL QUEEN:** (Sings.) Everyone can't be as evil as me!
- OTHERS:** (Sing.) We believe you!
- EVIL QUEEN:** (Sings.) I'm contemptible, tax exemptible,
35 Tell me, do you agree?
- OTHERS:** (Sing.) Oh, yeah!
She's contemptible, tax exemptible,
Yes, my queen, we agree!
- 40 **EVIL QUEEN:** (A shout, in rhythm.) Let's dance! (DANCE/ INSTRUMENTAL
INTERLUDE.)

1 **ALL:** *(Sing.)* Hey, hey!
EVIL QUEEN: *(Sings.)* Everyone can't be as nasty as me!
OTHERS: *(Sing.)* We believe you!
EVIL QUEEN: *(Sings.)* I'll razzle, dazzle 'em, razzmatazzle 'em...
5 Everybody will see!
OTHERS: *(Sing.)* Oh, yeah!
She'll razzle, dazzle 'em, razzmatazzle 'em...
Hocus Pocus, they'll see!
ALL: *(Sing.)* They'll see! Hey, hey!
10 **OTHERS:** *(Sing.)* Everyone knows
She's as rough as a cob!
EVIL QUEEN: *(Indicates AUDIENCE.)* They believe you!
(Sings.) Reprehensible, let's be sensible,
I'm the girl for the job!
15 **OTHERS:** *(Sing.)* Oh, yeah!
She's reprehensible, let's be sensible,
She's the girl for the job!
ALL: *(A shout in rhythm.)* Yeah! *(ALL EXIT amidst chatter and laughter
as MUSIC CONTINUES UNDER. MUSIC OUT. LIGHTS SHIFT to DOWN
20 CENTER on the woods. LITTLE RED ENTERS UP LEFT, skipping along
with her basket of cookies and a map. The WOLF, looking lost and
confused, ENTERS UP RIGHT.)*
WOLF: *(Sings.)* I'm the girl for the job!

Wed Widing Hood Audition Script

End of PROLOGUE

Scene One

BEFORE LIGHTS UP: At the home of the HOODS. As the play opens,
10 MR. and MRS. HOOD are seated on a couch EXTREME DOWN RIGHT,
watching an imaginary television. MRS. HOOD rises and faces the
AUDIENCE.

MRS. HOOD: *(To AUDIENCE.)* Hey! Would you folks mind quieting down?
We're trying to watch TV here.

15 **MR. HOOD:** *(Rises to look at AUDIENCE.)* Yeah, we don't come into your
living room and make a racket. *(STAGE LIGHTS UP.)* Now, let's see
what's on. *(Points a large remote control, as if he were changing
channels.)*

LITTLE RED: *(ENTERS EXTREME DOWN RIGHT, carrying a Hula Hoop.)*
20 Mom, Dad? Can I go outside and play with my Hula Hoop when
I finish emptying the dishwasher? *(The HOODS do not respond.
LITTLE RED gives an exasperated sigh and EXITS.)*

MRS. HOOD: We've already seen this episode. Find something new.
(MR. HOOD again makes as if he is switching channels.) This looks
25 good. It's one of those musical shows—look, it's Andy Williams.
(The HOODS settle into their couch.)

LITTLE RED: *(RE-ENTERS, still with Hula Hoop. MR. HOOD sets down the
remote.)* Hey, Mom! Dad! I finished with the dishes. I think I'll go
outside and play with my Hula Hoop. It's such a beautiful day.

30 **MR. HOOD:** But there's so much TV to watch. *(Looks around under
cushions, on floor, etc.)* Now where did that newfangled remote
controller go?

NARRATOR #1: *(ENTERS DOWN LEFT with a different remote control
and points it at the HOODS and LITTLE RED, who FREEZE. At the
35 same time, NARRATOR #2 ENTERS DOWN RIGHT.)* Wow, the pause
button really works! What did you say this thing is called?

NARRATOR #2: It's the Zenith Space Command remote control.
The one these folks have only changes channels, but this one is
special—it does all sorts of things.

1 **NARRATOR #1:** Like freezing the action?
NARRATOR #2: Exactly, and that will give us a chance to explain to all these nice people what's going on at the Hood household.

NARRATOR #1: That's right, folks. This is the home of the Hoods. Mr. and Mrs. Hood spend most of their time there on the couch in front of their black and white TV set. *(Points the remote control at the HOODS, who UNFREEZE.)*

5 **MR. HOOD:** Boy, some popcorn sure would taste good. *(NARRATOR #1 clicks the remote again and the HOODS FREEZE.)*

10 **NARRATOR #2:** They live with their daughter, Little Red Riding Hood. *(NARRATOR #1 points the remote control at LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD, and she UNFREEZES.)*

LITTLE RED: Fine, I'll make you some. *(To AUDIENCE.)* They're too lazy to make it themselves. Boy, my parents are really from dullsville.

15 **NARRATOR #1:** *(Clicks the remote again, FREEZING LITTLE RED.)* Poor Little Red Riding Hood—she has lazy parents, and she suffers from all the problems of being the youngest child.

NARRATOR #2: There are other children?

NARRATOR #1: Oh, I'm sorry. I almost forgot. *(Clicks the remote control again. MEDIUM PURPLE RIDING HOOD and BIG GREEN RIDING HOOD ENTER EXTREME DOWN RIGHT, talking to each other. MEDIUM PURPLE wears glasses and carries a book. She has all the appearances of a "brain." BIG GREEN is dressed in workout attire and appears to be a jock.)*

20 **MEDIUM PURPLE:** Justin is definitely a dream boat—the cutest prince in the kingdom.

BIG GREEN: Nah-uuh! Jason is much cuter. *(Dreamy.)* He's the most!

NARRATOR #1: *(Clicks remote and FREEZES MEDIUM PURPLE and BIG GREEN.)* Meet Little Red Riding Hood's older sisters, Big Green Riding Hood and Medium Purple Riding Hood. *(Clicks and the THREE GIRLS UNFREEZE.)*

30 **BIG GREEN:** Anyway, Justin would never marry you. You're too much of a brain.

MEDIUM PURPLE: Well, Jason wouldn't even ask you on a date. I don't think he's into weight lifting. *(MUSIC CUE 2: "Boys, Boys!")*

35 **LITTLE RED:** *(Speaks.)* If you ask me, Frank's the cutest. And he's the only one who's not stuck up.

ALL: *(Sing.)* Boys, boys! You can't live with 'em!
Boys, boys! You can't live without 'em!

40 Boys, boys! They like to poke fun,
But still I'm gonna get me one!
